Show Team

If you're looking to expand your riding opportunities, you might want to consider horse showing. Our show team is comprised of current lesson students at NFF, both children and adults, beginner through advanced riders. This means that anyone can join the team. Our season runs from January through November, with several shows scheduled each month throughout the season. All team members are required to show in at least three shows for the season – but you may show in more, if you'd like!

Summer Camps

We offer a few camps over the summer - for riders of all levels. And we have our very special 6-day camp with a different theme every summer...from eventing, to foxhunting, to polo - it's a week to learn something new!

Tuesday Talks

To continue our riders' education, we offer these informative ground lessons on the first Tuesday of each month. Topics range from how to bathe a horse, to healthcare, to braiding! Open to all our riders.

Foxhunting

Our students can give foxhunting a try and ride as a guest with Potomac Hunt! You can use one of our horses, and we'll trailer you to the hunt and supervise you while out in the field. Youth may also join Potomac's Junior Hunt program, and hunt as a member several times throughout the year.

Trail Riding

We try and incorporate trail riding as part of our lessons, but occasionally we offer group trail rides either here on the property, or to neighboring Woodstock Horse Park.

And More Fun!

We offer lots of fun throughout the year...a barn group trip to the Washington International Horse Show (where our barn has won Best Spirited Group and won Best Video!). We host shows and clinics throughout the year. And we're a proud host barn of the Interschool Horse Show Series. We also offer some of our lesson horses for half-lease...and if you're ready to purchase your own horse, we can help you find the perfect match! *NFF Stables...a barn for all riders!*



Lesson Prices

Group Lessons

\$250 for a set of 6 one-hour group lessons

Private Lessons

\$280 for a set of 6 half-hour private lessons

Semi-Private Lessons (2 riders)

\$300 per person for a set of 6 one-hour semi-private lessons

Beginner Lessons

\$230 for first set of 6 half-hour private lessons (new riders only). After completion of the first set of six private lessons, rider may continue with private lessons at the normal rate, or join a group lesson (if available) at the normal rate. We do not offer group Beginner Lessons.

Family Lesson Discount

For riders from the same immediate family who are all currently enrolled in lessons:

Group Lessons: \$235 per rider

Private Lessons: \$265 per rider

Semi-Private Lessons: \$285 per rider

Payment is expected at the first lesson of each set.

Riders who have not paid for the set after three lessons are ineligible to ride until payment is made.

When you have taken the fifth lesson of your set, you will receive an email invoice for the next set.

If you are not continuing, please let us know!

Lesson Information:

- All riders must wear an approved ASTM-SEI hard hat. We have plenty of hard hats in a variety of sizes, so don't go out and buy anything until you're sure riding is for you
- Riders must wear long pants, and closed toe shoes (preferably boots, but hiking and snow boots won't work). Tennis shoes are acceptable for beginner riders
- Students need to arrive at least 15 minutes before the lesson to groom and tack, and allow at least 15 minutes after the lesson for cooling down, grooming and tack cleaning.
- We have a very flexible cancellation policy, but you need to let us know if you're not able to attend (call, email, Facebook or even text - even if it's right before your lesson). If you don't acknowledge your cancellation, you will be charged for the lesson.
- Please park in the parking lot only - do not drive between the barns or down towards the indoor ring. When approaching the indoor arena, call out "door" before entering so riders (and horses) know there is activity at the door. Please do not stand in the doorway of the arena (we have plenty of seats). And please, no outside dogs!

This Liability Release binds not only the Releaser with regard to any claims arising from participation in these activities, but also the Releaser's spouse, heirs, legal guardian, legal representatives and assigns.

In consideration of the above stated purposes and the Releaser's permission to be on the premises of NFF Stables, LLC, the Releaser forever releases, discharges and covenants to hold NFF Stables, LLC, their employees, successors, assigns and legal representatives harmless from any and all claims, demands, costs, expenses, loss of services, acts and causes of action which may arise from any act or occurrence on account of any personal injury, disability, property damage, loss or damages of any kind sustained or that may hereafter be sustained by the Releaser in consequence of any act that may be occasioned on account of Releaser being on the premises of NFF Stables, LLC, or that Releaser may sustain because of Releaser's proximity to horses and horse-related activities.
